DATE OF TOURNAMENT February 25-27th at Platteview High School, Springfield, Nebraska.

DIVISIONS Boys/Girls Teams--Grades 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th

PLAYERS Players must compete in their grade classification. (Exception: Younger players may participate in older division.)

REGISTRATION Registration fee for all teams is \$125.00 plus \$5.00 per player over 10 players.

- We ask that teams please pay with 1 check payable to the SYAA Basketball.
- No Refunds.
- Weather Cancellation: A \$50.00 fee will be retained if the tournament is canceled.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE Final Registration **deadline is: February 14th, 2011.**

GAME TIMES Game times will start at 8:00 a.m. each day (if play is needed on Friday we will start at 6:00.)

AWARDS All teams will be scheduled for 3 games.

- 8 Team Brackets = 4 Team Awards (1st, 2nd in the "A" bracket and 1st, 2nd in the "B" bracket).
- 6 Team Brackets = 3 Team Awards (1st, 2nd, 3rd)
- 4 Team Brackets = 2 Team Awards (1st, 2nd)

OFFICIALS/SCOREKEEPERS Two registered officials and a clock operator will be provided for all games. The home team (bottom team on bracket) will be responsible for providing a scorekeeper. Electronic score boards will be used for all games.

PAIRINGS INFORMATION All tournament information (schedules, rules, site locations, etc.) will be available on-line at <http://www.syaaonline.org/pcctourney.htm> on Monday, February 21st, 2011.

T-SHIRTS Official tournament T-Shirts will be on sale at the site.

IMPORTANT:

The PCC tournament consists of 4, 6, or 8 team individual brackets/for each grade level. There is no set number of individual tournaments per grade level, only that there be even numbers. We are limited to 64 total teams. As the team entry forms are received for a particular grade level, they are held until an even number is created. Therefore, while February 14th may be the final deadline - that does not mean a team is automatically included in the tournament.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Where: Platteview High School, 108th & Platteview Rd., Springfield, NE
(5 miles south of Omaha)

Games: Guaranteed 3 games, there may be games on Friday night.

Awards: Medals will be given to 1st and 2nd place teams in brackets with 4 teams.
Medals will be given to 1st and 2nd and 3rd place with 5 or more teams in the bracket.

Sites: Platteview High School

Registration Fee: \$125 per team - PLEASE REGISTER BY February 14th, 2011

Tournament Rules:

- 8 minute quarters
- Clock stops on free throws and time-outs
- Clock stops the last 30 seconds on all whistles for quarters 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- Clock stops the last 1 minute on all whistles of the 4th quarter
- 1st Overtime is 2 minute overtime with clock running until final 30 seconds
- All other overtimes will be 1 minute with clock running until final 30 seconds. (30 second time-out between)
- Provide your own warm-up balls
- Be ready to play 15 minutes prior to game
- PRESSING - All divisions may press to specific lead. (4th Grade -4th quarter only)
- 4th, 5th and 6th grade teams can press to a 15 point lead.
- 7th and 8th grade teams can press to a 20 point lead.
- 2 - full time-outs and 1 - 30 second time-out per game, (1st overtime each team gets 1 time-out - no carryover) (no time-outs after 1st overtime)
- 10 foot basket for all divisions
- Bonus free throw on the 7th foul, double bonus on the 10th
- Unless otherwise noted, all other Nebraska high school basketball rules will apply
- Admission: Adults - \$4 per day
 Students - \$2 per day, Under 5 - free
